### SCHOOL RESUMES CLASSROOM TEACHING

Regular classes for IX to XII have been resumed at Sainik School Rewari with the strict compliance to COVID-19 Protocol. It is worth noting that due to the COVID-19 transition. Online classes were started in the Academic

Session for the smooth conduct of educational work of cadets in the School. As per the instructions of Sainik School Society, regular educational work have started in the School at various stages. Class X and XII were sent for in the first phase.



The School Principal Soumyabrata Dhar said that all the guidelines set by the government for reopening the residential School will be strictly followed.
