## PROUD COMMENCEMENT OF THE OFFICER LEGACY

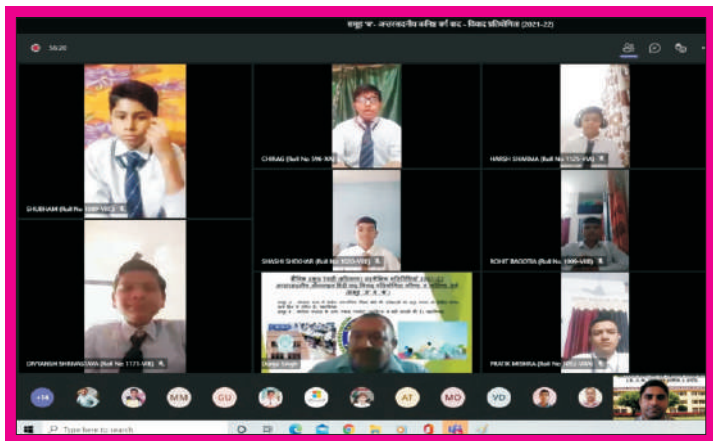

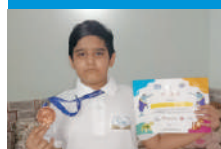

## VISIT OF SAINIK AND ARDH SAINIK WELFARE MINISTER



Haryana's Sainik and Ardh Sainik Welfare Minister Om Prakash Yadav reviewed the progress of construction work of Sainik School along with Deputy Commissioner Yashendra Singh, Principal Sainik School, Executive Engineer PWD along with other officers related to Sainik School permanent building construction work on 18<sup>th</sup> June 2021. MLA Kosli Laxman Yadav was also present on this occasion.

The Minister Om Prakash Yadav said that the government is trying to start classes for children in the new Sainik School building as soon as possible, so the pending construction work of Sainik School should be completed soon. He said that the concerned officers should complete the pending works related to their respective departments forthwith so that classes can be started at the earliest. In this review meeting, Superintendent Engineer PWD VS Malik has sent the estimate for the necessary repair work of the already prepared staff quarters and administrative building to the headquarters by next week. He informed that the road construction work is going on in the school premises and the work is going on for the remaining construction work of some other residential buildings of the Staff. Apart from other works girls hostel, multipurpose hall, ground, Indoor Ground, Shopping Complex etc. work is also in progress.

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
