## MOTIVATIONAL LECTURE ON INDIAN NAVY




An online motivational lecture on Indian Navy was delivered by Cdr Jacob Tom on 23 Nov 2021 for the cadets of Class XII.

#### **CBSE TERM - I EXAMINATION**

A new assessment plan has been implemented by CBSE for academic session 2021-22. The complete academic session has been divided into two Terms. Exams of Term I are based on almost 50% of the syllabus while Term II will be based on the remaining 50%. As per the new scheme, the exams will be of90 minutes duration having Multiple Choice Questions(MCQs) for Class IX to XII. Apropos, School conducted Pre Board exams wef 10-17 Nov 2021 for Class X, followed by Term1 Examination of Class IX to XII from 29 Nov 2021. Term-1 Practical exam for Class XI & XII has also been conducted from 24 Nov to 27 Nov as per new CBSE Pattern.


