The Committee on due deliberations on the various aspects, recommended that the earliest timeline to shift the School, is four months from the issue of Administrative approval and release of funds for Special Repair of Academic Block and other residential quarters, which have already been constructed and completed in 2015.

# HOW I PREPARED FOR MY NDA WRITTEN EXAM



My preparation for the Written Exam started in the month of June 2020 although I had been preparing hard sinceclass 9 for this exam. However, a systematic and proper preparation started the day after I filled up my application form for NDA exam. On the one hand, the whole world was undergoing tough times of Corona virus pandemic while on the other hand I had to prepare for my exam. I was very certain that I have to clear this exam at any cost and for this I charted out a routine including eight hours study per day by giving more attention towards Mathematics. For Mathematics, firstly I revised all Class 11<sup>th</sup> concepts with the help of NCERT and Elements book, then I went through Pathfinder and Previous Years Questions, practiced them under time constraints, took help of Mr Murli Manohar and Mr Vivek for difficult and weak portions, watched some YouTube videos and kept practicing the topics. For class 12<sup>th</sup> portion I went through NCERT, thereafter Elements book, solved most of the questions of both the books. I also went through Previous Years Questions and Pathfinder book, solved all type of questions. Mock tests conducted by the School played a great role in boosting my confidence. I worked on my weak areas, analyzed my performance, kept taking feedback from Mathematics teachers. As GAT also plays an important role in clearing the Written Exam so I kept a pace with it as well. For English I only went through Online classes conducted by Miss Anupriya Priyadarshi and it has helped me a lot, solved Previous Years Questions and kept on taking guidance from Ma'am. For Science, I would just recommend my juniors to go through Class 9<sup>th</sup> and 10th Science book and religiously attended all the classes conducted by Science teachers because most of the questions asked in the Exam are either discussed or already done in the class.

For Social Sciences, I went through some YouTube channels of Grade up, MGS Academy and Chankya Academy, attended some school classes, solved Previous Year Questions and Online quizzes. A sense of satisfaction and ecstasy dawned upon me the day our result was announced and it was like that I have paid for what I was at the School. It was only possible due to the valuable guidance of our worthy teachers and their hard efforts.
