56 cadets of Class VI along with three teachers visited Air Force Museum, Palam and National War Memorial on 03 Aug 2022. The cadets got a glimpse of history of IAF at the Museum. They were astonished to see historic photographs, memorabilia, uniforms and personal weapons of the Indian



Air Force since its inception in 1932. They also visited the National War Memorial, a national monument built to honour and remember soldiers of the Indian Armed Forces who fought in various wars of independent India.
