IN-SERVICE TEACHERS TRAINING

Sainik Schools Society has planned two weeks In-Service Training, at IITE, Gandhinagar for all the teachers of Sainik Schools, in various batches, to be executed by Dec 2022.



The first week of the training is through offline mode at IITE, Gandhinagar and the second week through online mode is attended by the teachers from their respective Schools. The third batch started from 13 June - 28 June 2022, wherein three teachers Sh Hemant Kumar, Sh V K Dwivedi and Sh Y K Singhal of this School alongwith 97 teachers from other Sainik Schools, attended this training. In the fourth batch three teachers, Sh Durga Singh Shekhawat, Sh Ravinder Kumar and Sh Bhawani Singh Shekhawat of this School attended the training wef 18 July - 02 Aug 2022 alongwith 96 teachers from other Sainik Schools. The training benefitted the participating teachers not only in enriching and updating their knowledge but also in infusing new life into classroom, delivery of lessons thereby improving the learning outcome of the students. During the course of the seven day training programme. lectures were conducted by eminent educationists from reputed Education and Research institutions, on inclusiveness in education, integration of NDA & CBSE, pedagogy of online teaching, ethical practices in residential Schools, needs of coeducation Schools and the teaching methodologies to be adopted for deeper impact on the students.

Cadet Veer Pratap topped the batch with 96.8%. Similarly, out of the 37 cadets of Class XII, 28 cadets scored above 75% and remaining nine cadets scored above 70%. Cadet Mayank Rohila of Class XII topped the batch with 88.8%.
