CBSE CLASS X & XII RESULTS

CBSE Class X & XII results were declared on 12 May 2023, wherein the School performed well in both classes. Out of the 81 cadets of Class X for the AY 2022-23, 13 cadets scored above 90%, 47 cadets scored between 89-75% and 09 cadets scored between 74-70%. Cadet Harsh Thakran topped the class with 93.60%. Similarly, out of the 52 cadets of Class XII, 25 cadets scored above 75% and remaining 27 cadets scored above 61%. Cadet Akshay Kumar of Class XII topped with 94.10%.
