PARENT TEACHER MEETING

The Parent Teacher Meeting was conducted on 5 April, 2024, during which the results of the academic session 2023-24 were discussed and provided to the parents. The cadets' academic performance and overall developmental points were discussed in detail by the respective subject and class teachers.

INTER HOUSE ENGLISH DEBATE COMPETITION

An Inter-House English Debate Competition for Group 'A' and Group 'B' was organized on 27 April 2024. The topic of the debate for Group 'A' was "A common man is a silent instigator under the cloak of a mute spectator" and for Group 'B' the topic was "Every citizen should be mandated to perform National Public Service." In Group 'A', Cadet Aayush (1481), Class X of Katari House, secured the first position, and in Group 'B', Cadet Parth (1543), Class VII of Katari House, secured the first position. With the combined point system, Katari House won the Inter-House Debate Competition.



INTER HOUSE VOLLEYBALL COMPETITION

An Inter-House Volleyball Tournament was conducted from 17 April, 2024, to 19 April, 2024, at the school volleyball ground. The final match was played between Subroto and Carriappa House. Subroto House won the match with a score of 2-0. Cadet Rohan (855) was declared the best volleyball player of the tournament. The girls' volleyball match was played between Kargil and Rezagla House, in which Rezagla House won the match with a score of 2-1. Cadet Muskaan (1298) was declared the best girl player.



INTER HOUSE FOOTBALL COMPETITION

An Inter-House Football Competition was conducted from 9 April 2024 to 12 April 2024 at the school football ground in Group 'A'. The final match was played between Pereira and Carriappa House. Carriappa House won the final match with a score of 1-0. Cadet Mohit Pandey (884) was adjudged the best football player. In Group 'B', the final match was played between Manekshaw House and Katari House. Katari House won the match with a score of 6-0. Cadet Bharat (1406) was adjudged the best football player. A football match was also organized for girl cadets between Kargil and Rezagla House. Kargil House won the match with a score of 2-0. Cadet Parul (1307) was adjudged the best football player.



MOTIVATIONAL LECTURE BY DISHA CELL

A motivational lecture was organized for cadets of Class IX-XII at the school conference hall on 30 April, 2024. The session was conducted to guide and motivate cadets to join the NDA and perform well in the SSB. Three cadets from NCC (I) Coy, Sainik School Rewari (Cadet Chirag, Cadet Prince, and Cadet Jatin), participated in the camp. They visited the Hydropower Plant on 18 May 2024. On 20 May 2024, they travelled about 18 km and trekked to Majheotti Mountain. On 21 May 2024, the cadets trekked to Devdhang, covering a distance of 15 km. Additionally, the cadets participated in various other activities conducted during the camp.

CBSE CLASS X & XII RESULTS



The CBSE Class X and XII results were announced on 13 May 2024, with the school showing strong performance in both classes. Among the 72, Class X cadets for the academic year 2023-24, 23 cadets achieved scores above 90%, 43 cadets scored between 75-89%, and 1 cadet scored between 70-74%. Cadet Aryan Kumar Singh was the top scorer in Class X with 97.60%. In Class XII, out of 43 cadets, 13 scored above 75%, while the remaining 30 cadets scored above 60%. Cadet Keshav Yadav was the top scorer in Class XII with 86.60%.
